**To:** Respected Officials of Supreme, Divisions, Primary, and Appeal Courts! Allah's mercy, blessings, and peace be upon you!

The General Directorate of the Secretariat presented a proposal to the Supreme Court High Council meeting on March 8, 2022 (5/8/1443LY) with the following text:

The letter No. 405, dated June 16, 2019, of the Courts High Authority of Islamic Emirate of Afghanistan was sent to all the courts with the following text:

Some courts had asked for an explanation about Article 14 of the Administrative Code, so we thought it appropriate to send this explanation to all courts that are as follows:

(Where a party is not satisfied with the Primary Court approved reconciliation, this dissatisfaction has two states;

First: where the unsatisfied party claims that the reconciliation is not Sharia-based, the Primary Court-approved reconciliation can go to appeal and supreme [court].

Second: where the unsatisfied party does not claim that the reconciliation is not Sharia-based, but he is not satisfied only because the decision is not in his favor, in such a case, the Primary Court approved reconciliation does not have any appeal to the supreme [court].)

As the text above had [already] been sent to all Afghanistan Islamic Emirate courts, it is therefore proposed to your excellency to instruct whether to resend it; any instruction to this end shall be acted upon.))

In connection with the abovementioned letter, the High Council, based on approval No. (41) dated 5/8/1443LY (March 8, 2022) instructed as follows:

((The Secretariat Directorate General has to send the mentioned letter as a circular to all courts.))
