To: The Directorates of Cassations, Divisions, Appellate, and Primary Courts of the Islamic Emirate of Afghanistan!

Greetings:

Decree number (342V1) dated 27 February 2022, of the Supreme Leader of the Islamic Emirate of Afghanistan regarding not charging fees on the petitions, decisions, and documents of courts has been communicated as follows:

“Previously, any fees that have been charged on petitions, decisions, and courts and have been deposited in the banks shall no longer be charged in the future.”

We have sent the above-mentioned decree of the Supreme Authority of the Islamic Emirate of Afghanistan to the Supreme Court, which has issued the following guidance in such regard:

“The aforementioned decree of the Supreme Leader shall be sent to all the courts of the Islamic Emirate of Afghanistan, and the courts shall refrain from receiving fees from petitions, decisions, and documents in the courts based on the aforementioned decree.”

The steps contained in the guidance of the Supreme Court regarding the decree of the Supreme Authority are hereby extended through this circular to all the directorates of the cassation courts, divisions, and primary and appellate courts of the Islamic Emirate of Afghanistan to act in the light of the above guidelines.
