Given that a number of our compatriots have resided in foreign countries for several decades, and others inhabit regions under the jurisdiction of the Kabul administration, some of whom are aligned with our adversaries, it is unequivocally stated that no one has the right to infringe upon their private property rights. Neither the Mujahideen nor any other parties can lay claim to their assets. Any attempt to confiscate land or other properties that contradicts Sharia principles or the rulings of Sharia courts is strictly prohibited. Any forgery, excuse, or reason for not adhering to Sharia law will not be tolerated. The perpetrators will be given Sharia punishment to prevent usurpation and save them from accusation.
