Order of His Excellency Amirul Momenin, May Allah protect him, on delegation of monetary authorities to ministries and budgetary institutions in procurement affairs

No. (778) Date: 14/3/1444 A.H. (10 October 2022)

The following powers are delegated to the ministries and budgetary institutions to ensure transparency, effective services delivery, settlement of issues, and regulating operations of procurement-related affairs:

- 1. Thirty-Five Million Afghanis in procuring non-consultative services of assets (these are the activities with no aspect of consultative services, purchasing of assets and construction matters, covering rental, leasing, maintenance costs of houses, offices, vehicles, warehouses, labor wages, and so forth).
- 2. Twenty Million Afghanis procuring consultative services (activities with specialized, intellectual, and consultative status, including designing, monitoring, education, developing software, ideas, and recommendations of the experts, and other similar technical, professional, and informational services).
- 3. Fifty Million Afghanis procuring construction-related services (construction, reconstruction, destruction, reconstruction of a building from scrape, preparation of the area, excavations, installation, montage, decoration affairs, as well as drilling their ancillary services, mapping, photography, and other similar services carried out according to the contents of a contract, provided that value of ancillary services must not exceed the cost of the building itself. Ancient buildings with historical and cultural value shall be exempted from this order).
- 4. Where procurement costs of (non-consultative and construction affairs-related services) of the ministries and budgetary institutions exceed the amounts referred to above, they shall dispatch procurement-related documents for evaluation and decision to the National Procurement Commission.
