Circular No: 4

Date: September 11, 2023

Decree No. 30, dated March 21, 2022, issued by His Excellency Amirul Momineen (May Allah protect him), directs the following to all entities within the Islamic Emirate:

"We instruct all officials of the Islamic Emirate to cease the appointment of relatives or close friends based solely on familial or personal connections. Such actions are sinful and risk incurring the wrath and punishment of Almighty God."

The decree further specifies that "ministers, deputy ministers, general directors of independent institutions, department heads, and sub-directors are prohibited from appointing their fathers, sons, brothers, nephews, uncles, fathers-in-law, brothers-in-law, and sons-in-law."

In compliance with this directive, all departments and oversight bodies at both the central and provincial levels are to clearly indicate in their relevant reports if such appointments have been made within their respective offices.

It should be noted that officials and authorities within the Emirate are permitted to appoint relatives to positions such as drivers, housekeepers, chefs, and guards.
