To the Islamic Emirate of Afghanistan's appeals court, divisions, and primary courts!

Peace be upon you and God's mercy and blessings!

Ruling No. 9, dated October 12, 2021, issued by the leader of the Islamic Emirate, His Excellency Amirul Momineen Sheikh Sahib (may God save him), concerns the handling of officials and employees of the previous government as follows:

Following the amnesty decree, this supplementary fatwa pertaining to the punishment and non-punishment of criminals from the previous corrupt administration has been issued by scholars and confirmed by the Supreme Audit Institution. I also confirm this fatwa. Therefore, conduct activities in accordance with this fatwa.

The aforementioned ruling of the Islamic Emirate, along with the scholars' fatwa, was submitted to the supreme authority of the Supreme Court, which issued the following guideline:

In accordance with the decree of Amir al-Mominin Sheikh Sahib, the leader of the Islamic Emirate of Afghanistan, the mentioned fatwa has been approved. It should be sent to all courts of the Islamic Emirate, making its use in judicial affairs mandatory.
