Announcement about Kabul Province Parks

All owners and officials of the parks of Kabul city and in its vicinity are hereby informed that Sundays, Mondays, and Tuesdays have been allocated for women to go to parks while observing Islamic Hijab. In these days, Mujahideen and other men are not allowed to go to the parks. In addition, Wednesdays, Thursdays, Fridays and Saturdays have been allocated for men. However, if Mujahideen enter these parks in the days allocated for men, they should avoid entering with their weapons and military uniform according to (article 5 of Resolution No. 21) of the Cabinet. Moreover, failing to comply with this notification shall result in legal actions to be taken against owners and officials of the parks.

Note:

In the recreation parks that are part of Kabul province, such as Paghman Dara (Valley), Shakardara, Estalif Dara, and other places where people go for picnic along with their families, women must observe Islamic Hijab and avoid getting closer to strangers. And, in case of any violation, legal action will be taken against them and they will then have no right to complain.
