Decree of His Excellency Amir al-Momenin on Prohibition of Selling Retrieved Emirati (State-owned) Lands from Usurpers

No. 666 Date: 27/09/2023

Article 01:

- (1) "It is forbidden to sell Emirati (state-owned) land that has been reclaimed from usurpers to usurpers and/or illegal possessors in provincial centers and cities."
- (2) In accordance with paragraph (1) of this article, which forbids the sale of retrieved Emirati (state-owned) land to usurpers or illegal possessors in provincial centers and cities, Articles 9 and 10 of the Law on the Prevention of Usurpation of Lands and Restitution of Usurped Lands, published in Official Gazette No. (1438) of the year 1445 AH (2023), shall be suspended.

Article 02:

In accordance with Decree No. (750) dated 13 July 2023 and Order No. (208) dated 25 October 2023 of the Supreme Leader, illegal possessors shall be allowed to lease the land specified in Article 01 of this decree.

Article 03:

This decree shall enter into force from the date of endorsement and shall be published in the official gazette.
