Ruling No. (9), dated October 13, 2022, from the Leadership of the Islamic Emirate, His Excellency Amirul Momineen Sheikh Sahib (May God protect him), concerning the treatment of officials and employees of the previous government, is as follows:

Following the amnesty decree, this supplementary Fatwa addresses the punishment and non-punishment of offenders from the prior corrupt administration. Issued by esteemed scholars and confirmed by the Supreme Audit Institution, I hereby endorse this Fatwa. Consequently, conduct all activities in accordance with this Fatwa.

The above-mentioned ruling of the Islamic Emirate was submitted to the Supreme Court's highest authority, accompanied by the scholars' Fatwa. The Supreme Court then issued the following guideline:

In accordance with the decree of Amir al-Mominin Sheikh Sahib, the leader of the Islamic Emirate of Afghanistan, the aforementioned Fatwa has been approved. Hence, it must be circulated to all courts of the Islamic Emirate, making its implementation in judicial affairs compulsory.
